!!! Safety !!!

The Competitor must at all times:

- Keep the finger outside the trigger guard while clearing a malfunction.
- Keep the finger outside the trigger guard during loading, reloading, or unloading.
- Keep the finger outside the trigger guard while moving during a course of fire.
- Shooter may start with safety off and finger on trigger.

Failure to comply will result in a stage warning. Two warnings on a single stage will result in a stage disqualification. Stage disqualification will result in a recorded time of 90 seconds, 30 seconds for each string.

- A Competitor who causes an unintentional discharge will be stopped by a Safety Officer as soon as possible.
- A round striking the start target results in a stage disqualification.
- A round striking between the shooter and the start target results in a stage disqualification.
- If at any time during the course of fire, a Competitor allows the muzzle of the firearm to point rearward, that is to break the "170 degree rule" as defined by the Safety Officer, the Competitor will be stopped immediately. Such an action will result in a stage disqualification.
- If at any time during the course of fire, or while loading, reloading or unloading, a Competitor drops a firearm or causes it to fall, loaded or not, it is to be retrieved only by the Safety Officer. Dropped firearms must always be retrieved by a Safety Officer who will, after checking and/or clearing the firearm, place it directly into the Competitor's gun case or gun bag. Dropping an unloaded handgun or causing it to fall outside of a course of fire is not an infraction; however, a Competitor who retrieves a dropped gun will receive a match disqualification.
- Dropping a loaded gun will result in a match disqualification.

- Award for 1st and 2nd Place

- No Scopes or Compensators. Iron Sights Only.

Cowboy Division

- 2 Single Action Revolvers.
- 1 Lever or Pump Action Rifle.
- No Scopes or Compensators. Iron Sights Only.

Limited Division

Award for 1st and 2nd Place

- Revolver or Semi-Automatic Pistol.
- Lever or Pump or Semi-Automatic Rifle.
- No Scopes or Compensators. Iron Sight / Fiber
 Optic (non powered) Allowed .
- Flash Suppressor Allowed.

Open Division

Award for 1st and 2nd Place

- Revolver or Semi-Automatic Pistol.
- Lever or Pump or Semi-Automatic Rifle.
- Scopes or Fiber Optics or Red Dots and or Compensators ALLOWED.
- Flash Suppressor Allowed.

Shooting Format

Safety Meeting

- All shooters and spectators must wear eye and ear protection.
- No Gun is to be loaded EXCEPT on the firing line.
- Do Not Break the 170 degree rule.
- Follow all the directions of the Range Office (RO).

Loading

- Must take place under the supervision of the RO
- You MUST SHOW that your gun is CLEAR.
- Magazines may be loaded before coming to the firing line, but cannot be inserted until instructed. High capacity magazines are allowed.
- Count your rounds (Firing more than 11 rounds on a string will result in a penalty) NO RELOADS ON A STRING
- COWBOY ALL CHAMBERS CAN BE LOADED –
 LOADING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE FIRING LINE ONLY.
- All guns must be pointed down range at all times.
- Cowboy Stage guns onto the table.
- Semi Auto you may place your loaded magazines in the table.

Shooting

- Rifle and or Pistol in the Described Format.
- MAKE READY Load Magazine and chamber a round into the gun. Ready to fire.
- ARE YOU READY Acknowledge you are ready.
 (Pointing at the start target)
- STANDY BY TIMER BEEP
- SHOOT THE STAGE AS DIRECTED.
- SHOW CLEAR / GROUND GUN- Remove your magazine, eject any rounds, and show the gun clear if all strings have been complete, or ground the gun.
- MAKE READY NEXT STRING Switch guns and or magazines / Make the gun ready.
- 。 Repeat until stage is complete
- SHOW CLEAR BEFORE LEAVING THE FIRING LINE

Unloading

- Must take place under direct supervision at the Firing LINE
- Show that your gun is clear.
- Show your magazines are clear.
- Chambers are to be open.
- Return your guns to storage.

Score Card

- You must submit your score card for the stage when you arrive to shoot the stage.
 - You will shoot each stage 4 times.
 - Your score is a combination of Time, plus Penalties.
 - The highest score will be removed.
 - Your score will be the combination of the lowest scores.

Scoring

- Score is total time plus penalties.
- Targets 5-7
 - Targets can be shot in any order.
 - THE STOP TARGET MUST BE SHOT LAST.
- Maximum score is 30 seconds.
- Target that is missed after striking the stop plate 2 second penalty
- Shooting the stop target out of order 30 second penalty
- Stage Disqualification 90 second penalty
- 2nd Stage Disqualification = Match Disqualification





Targets: 8 Steel

Min Rounds: 7 for pistol and rifle

Strings: 4, best 3 for score

Penalties: 2 seconds per miss

30 sec missed stop plate

30 max per string

Stage procedure:


Start Signal: Audible

Stop Signal: Last shot fired.

Standing in box. Shooter declares stop plate to be used prior to beep.

Upon start signal, engage tombstone plates in any order from within box, then the declared stop plate. Only one stop plate needs to be engaged.

Called Stop Plate must be engaged last.
